No smoking inside. Smoking is permitted on the deck. Please extinguish butts and place in the container provided.

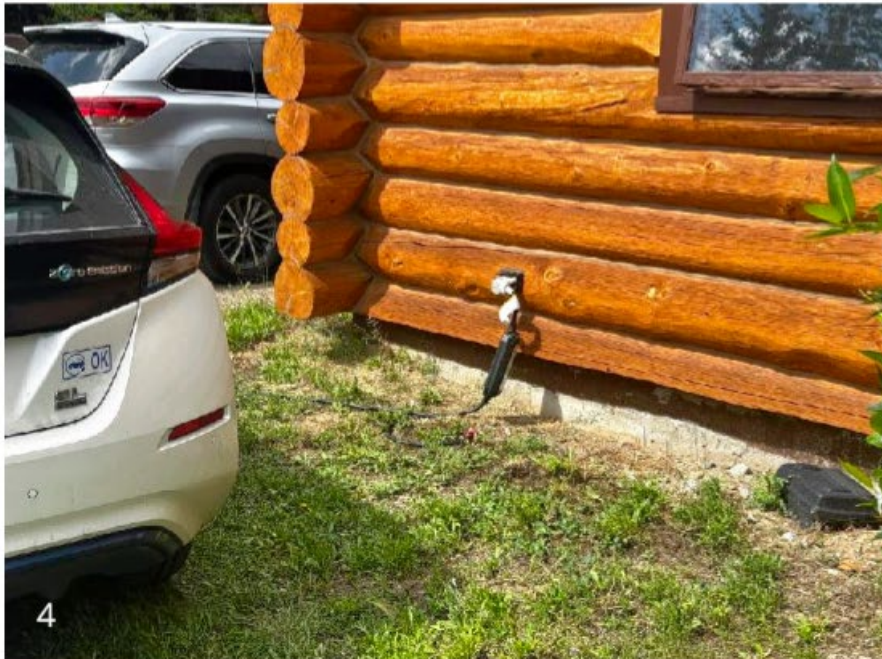

Power: There is an outlet behind the cabin that can be used to plug in EV (trickle charge with your own adapter) or your block heater in the winter.

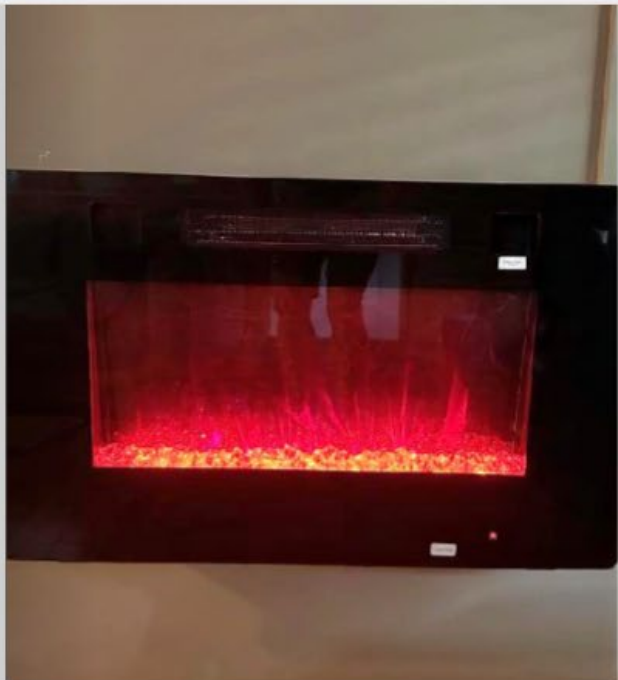


Wifi: Network is Peanutbutter. Password is 'badbean70'

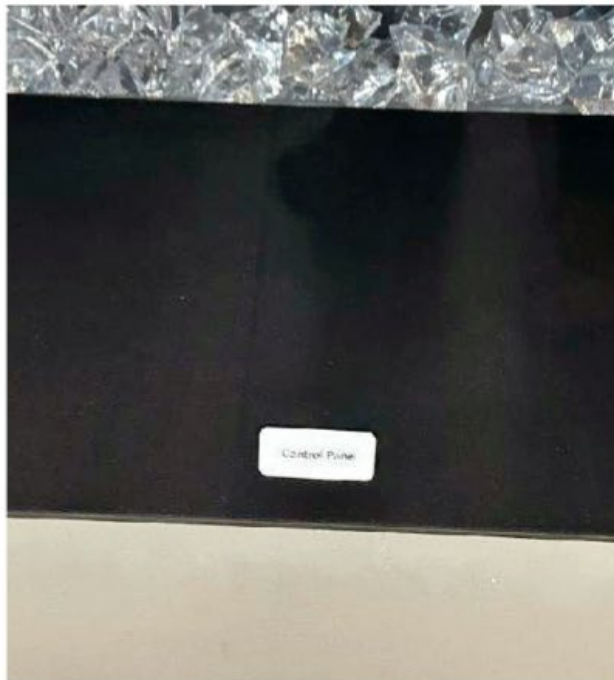


Settle in

Get cozy



The electric fireplace has a variety of settings and can be turned on or adjusted manually or with the remote. To use, make sure the switch on the top right is turned on. From there, you can use the remote or the buttons on the bottom right to adjust. You can change the colours and turn the forced air heat on or off.





The ceiling fan can help to keep things cool in the summer or warmer in the winter. There is a light switch for the fan and light to the right of the refrigerator.



This remote can also control the ceiling fan and light.



The thermostat shows the internal temperature inside the little house symbol and the external temperature above. You can press the buttons to 'set' the temperature of the electric baseboard heaters. The top button will set the temp higher and the lower button will set the temp higher.



The smart TV remote is this one. You can use it to watch TV or access Crave, Netflix, etc.

Get Caffeinated



Two choices for making coffee:
Nespresso Virtuo or
a Drip Coffeemaker



Instructions:

1. Fill the water tank with fresh drinking water.
2. Turn the machine "ON" by pushing the button.
3. Lights will blink for approximately 15 seconds while the machine is heating up. Steady light indicates the machine is ready.
4. Recommended cup sizes are: Alto: 414 ml, 230 ml for Mug / 150 ml for Gran Lungo / 40 ml for Espresso
5. The cup support has 3 positions and can be temporarily removed to accommodate various cup sizes.
6. Place a cup of sufficient capacity under the coffee outlet. Risk of scalding may occur due to overflowing.
7. Unlock and open the machine head completely.
8. This machine operates with Nespresso Vertuo capsules. Nespresso classic capsules cannot be used in this machine.
9. Insert a capsule with the dome shape at the bottom. Be careful not to injure yourself on sharp points or trap your fingers when reaching inside the machine.
10. Close the head and lock the machine by turning the lever left to the lock symbol on the machine head. NOTE: you can do this even when the machine is still heating up. The coffee will then flow automatically when the machine is ready.
11. Push the button to start the coffee preparation. It will take some time before the coffee flow comes out.
12. To stop the coffee flow early, push the button.
13. To manually top off your coffee, push the button and push again to stop when desired volume is reached.
14. Turn the lever to the right and open the head to automatically eject the capsule.

In the bedroom



The window has a lock if you want to crack it open for air. There is a fan you can use for white noise/air flow. The side tables have electrical outlets - just lift the front cover.





The sofa bed in the living area is easy to set up:

- 1) Move the coffee table and remove the pillows.
- 2) Lift the cover and pull out the extra part of the bed.
- 3) Pull the straps to lift the bed up.
- 4) Extra pillow and blanket are in the storage area.
- 5) Extra sheets are in the bedroom dresser.
- 6) Please put the sofa back together and fold blankets after use.

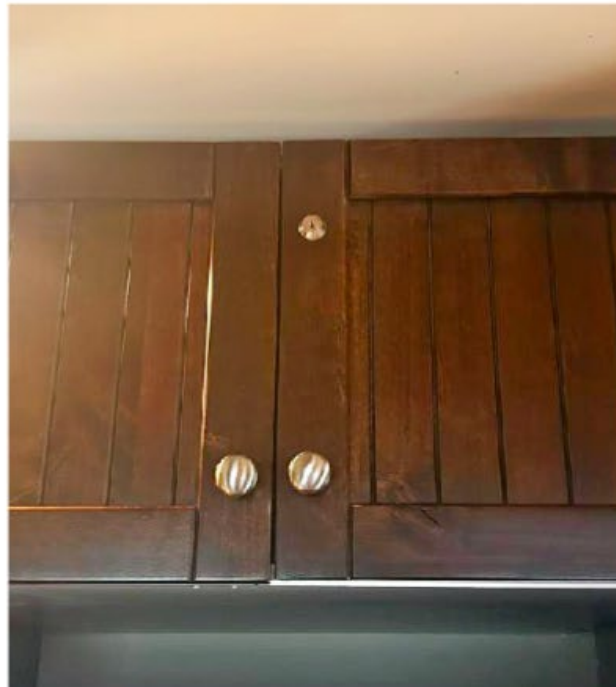
Sofa bed

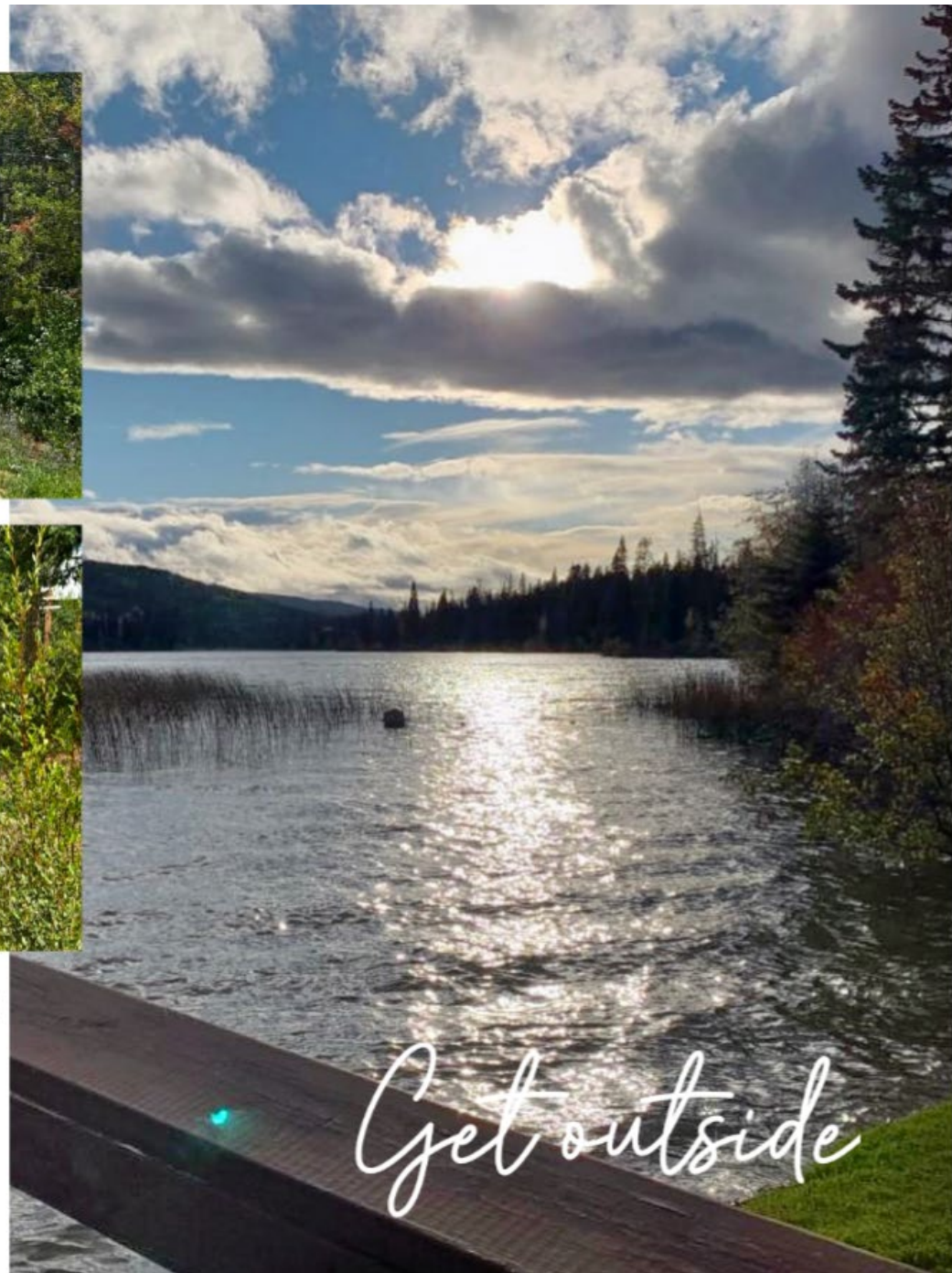
The trail beside the cabin leads up a short hill. This is a great place to see the stars on a clear night.



There is a short trail below the cabins that is good for a quick dog walk. Please clean up after your pets :)



Lac Le Jeune Provincial Park is 1.2 km from the cabin. There is plenty of day parking, a picnic area, a doggy beach, swimming and a fishing dock. The Gus Johnson Trail is a loop around the lake (approx. 11 km).



Get outside



The main resort firepit is beside the pond near the lodge. There is often firewood available, but you may need to bring your own. Please be safe: put your campfire out when you are done and be aware of any campfire bans.



There is a smaller campfire pit close to the cabin. It's just below cabin 14. There is a steep trail (careful!) beside cabin 15 or there is a set of stairs beside cabin 13.
